Directions to North Bend City Hall

Address: 920 SE Cedar Falls Wy, North Bend

From I-90, take exit 31 towards North Bend. At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto WA-202 W/N Bend Blvd N/Bendigo Blvd S. In approximately one half mile, turn right onto W Park St. In about a quarter mile at the traffic circle, take the first exit onto SE North Bend Wy. At the next traffic circle, take the first exit onto SE Cedar Falls Way. In about 0.4 miles, turn left into the parking lot.

From Duvall/Carnation, take SR 203 south to the intersection with SR 202 in Fall City. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto WA-202 E, and follow for about 8 miles, following the main road right onto Bendigo Blvd S. Turn left onto North Bend Way. At the traffic circle, continue straight onto E North Bend Way. At the next traffic circle, take the first exit onto SE Cedar Falls Way. In about 0.4 miles, turn left into the parking lot.
