Directions to the Salish Lodge:

**From I-90**, take exit 25 towards WA-18 E. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Echo Glen Rd/Snoqualmie Pkwy. Follow for approximately 3.5 miles and turn left onto Railroad Ave. At the roundabout, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit to continue onto Railroad Ave/WA-202 W for approximately 0.3 miles. The entrance to Salish Lodge will be on your left, 6501 Railroad Ave NE. Pull up to the front entrance; **all cars will be parked by the valet.**

**From the north**, take SR 203 from Duvall or Carnation to the intersection with SR 202 in Fall City. At the traffic circle, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto WA-202 E, and follow for 3.8 miles. The Salish lodge will be on your right, 6501 Railroad Ave NE. Pull up to the front entrance; **all cars will be parked by the valet.**
