DIRECTIONS: Carnation City Hall - 4621 Tolt Avenue (Highway 203).

From I-90 Eastbound, take the Preston Exit 22. At the end of the ramp, turn left and cross over I-90. Take the next right onto the Preston - Fall City Road and continue to Fall City. At Fall City, cross the Snoqualmie River and then take a left onto the Fall City - Carnation Rd (Highway 203). Drive north to Carnation (about 10 minutes). City Hall is on the west side of Tolt Avenue, next to the Police Station.
