

Proposed WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement Renewal Schedule

May 15, 2014

Background

The current WRIA 8 Interlocal Agreement (ILA) ends at the end of 2015. To continue the WRIA 8 salmon recovery effort, the ILA will need to be renewed. The proposed schedule below is intended to identify major milestones and help ILA partners prepare for renewing the ILA by November 2015.

Proposed ILA Renewal Schedule

- **July/September 2014**
 - WRIA 8 Implementation Committee review and provide feedback on:
 - Draft technical “clean-up” to update current ILA language
 - Substantive topics and potential changes for ILA renewal
 - WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Council reviews and provides feedback on revised ILA language. Revisions will distinguish between technical “clean-up” changes and potential substantive issue changes.
- **July/September – November 2014**
 - Salmon Recovery Council members seek initial feedback on revised ILA language from their respective jurisdictions.
- **November 2014 – May 2015**
 - Presentations to ILA partner jurisdictions. Presentations will be intended to update councils on the WRIA 8 salmon recovery effort, including priorities and updated implementation progress, as context for discussion of the ILA renewal.
- **May – July 2015**
 - WRIA 8 staff incorporates feedback and works with Implementation Committee and SRC to finalize ILA language.
- **July 2015**
 - Final ILA available for partner signatures. Secure all ILA partner signatures by November 20 SRC meeting.
- **November 2015**
 - Renewed ILA signed by all ILA partners by the November 20 SRC meeting.
