# Funding Process

- Request for Proposals
- WRIA 8 Project Subcommittee reviews proposals using grant review criteria
- Subcommittee's ranking informs funding recommendations
- Subcommittee's recommendations presented to Salmon Recovery Council
- Council-approved decisions forwarded to Flood Control District



# Cooperative Watershed Management Grant Program

- Funds provided by King County Flood Control District
- Eligible activities:
  - *Habitat restoration*
  - *Protection/acquisition*
  - *Monitoring/investigations*
  - *Outreach and education*
- WRIA 8 funding guidance: up to \$300,000 for monitoring; up to \$96,000 for outreach

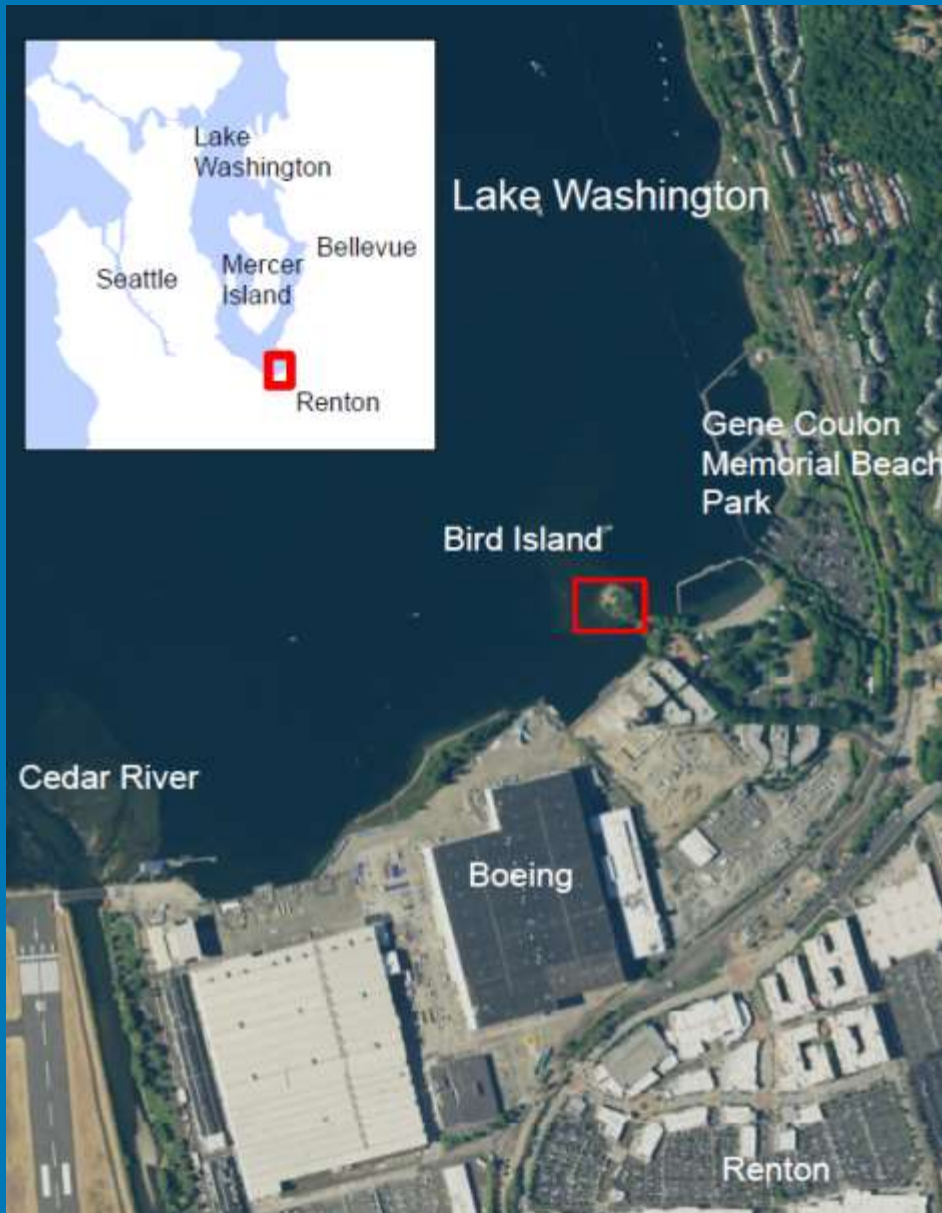
