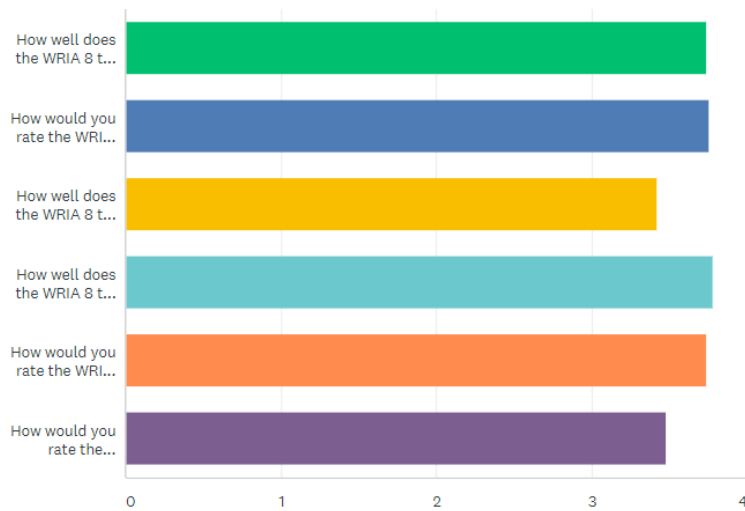

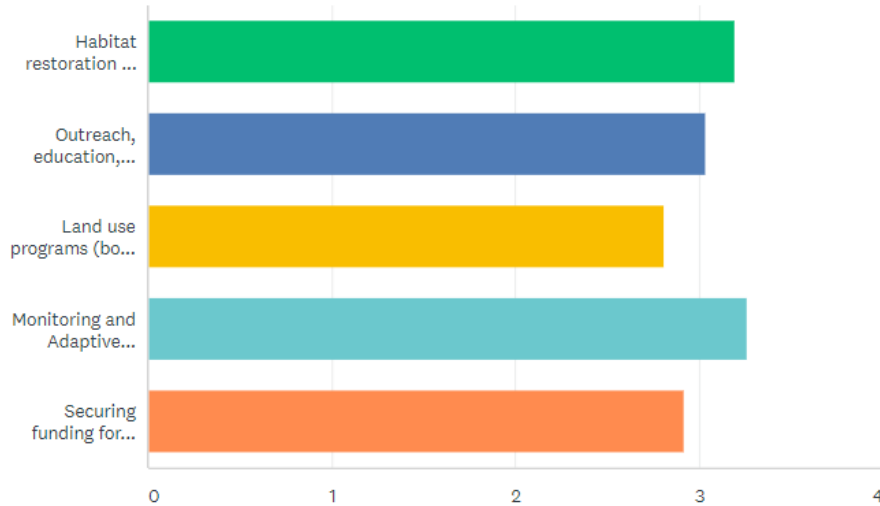

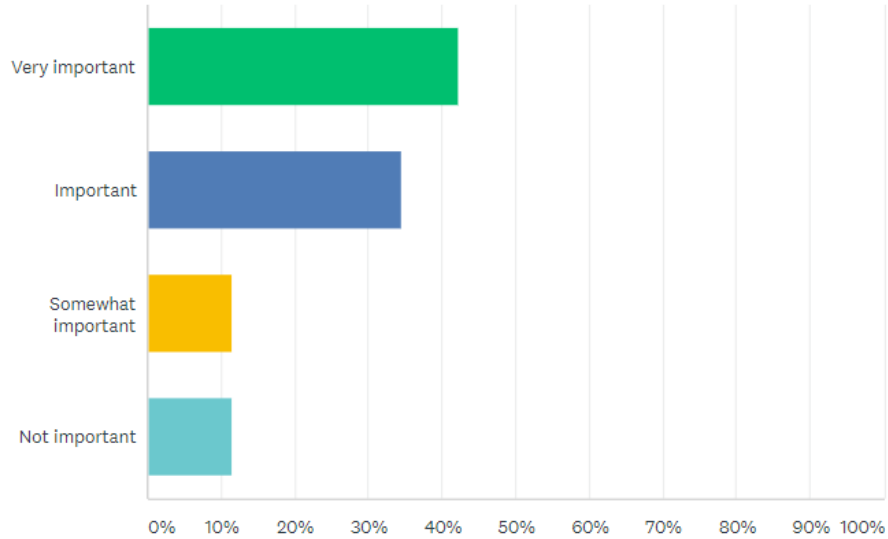

How important is it to you to cost share public outreach and communications?

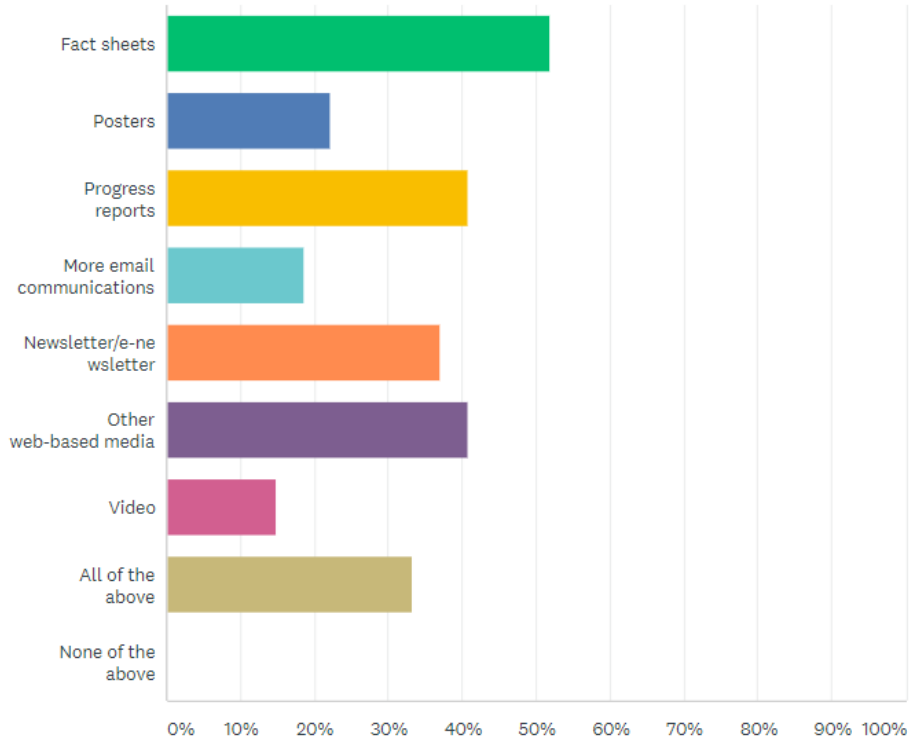

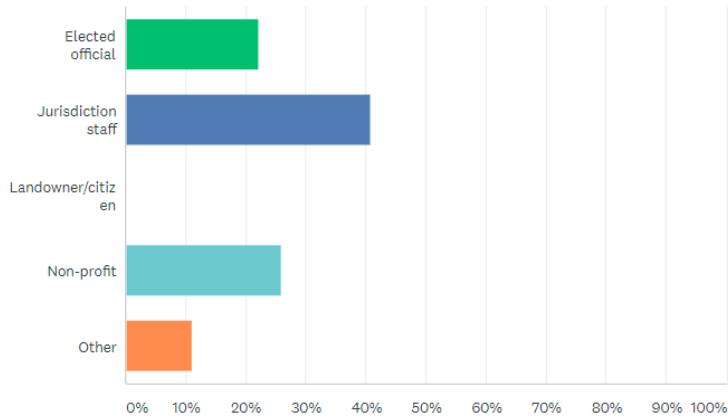

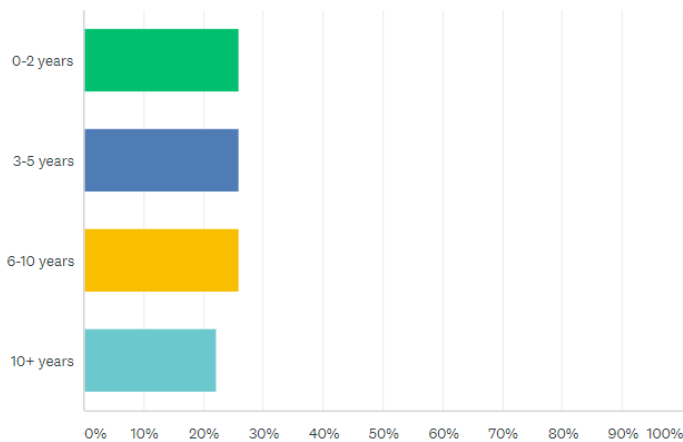
