Addressing priority knowledge gaps

- Convene a process to address elevated temperature and low dissolved oxygen in the Ship Canal
- Assess impacts and support management of predation on juvenile salmon by invasive, non-native predatory fish in the Ship Canal
- Document effects of artificial light on salmon behavior and survival and develop/support standards
- Understand effects of toxics and contaminants in water on salmon behavior and survival (e.g., tire rubber chemical in runoff causing pre-spawn mortality in coho salmon, etc.) and support efforts to reduce known priority toxic substances
- Work with local government and community partners to integrate findings into local codes, regulations, and outreach and incentive programs.
