March 23, 2022	<p><b><u>CWM Grant Application Deadline</u></b>            By 5:00 p.m., submit all required grant materials (CWM application form, CWM budget worksheet, the relevant supplemental application form, and other supporting materials) via email to <a href="mailto:cbyron@kingcounty.gov">cbyron@kingcounty.gov</a>.</p>
April 2022	<p><b><u>Site Visits and Presentations</u></b>            Grant applicants will give either virtual or in-person on-site presentations to the WRIA 8 Project Subcommittee. (The format, schedule and timing will be confirmed with applicants following the application deadline.)</p>
May 19, 2022	WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Council finalizes funding recommendations for transmittal to Flood Control District.
Summer 2022	King County Flood Control District Board of Supervisors issues funding decisions.
