February 8, 2023	<u>Results of Habitat Projects NOI Screening Notified</u> By this date, sponsors of habitat and riparian restoration projects will be notified whether they are being invited to move forward in the application process.
February 15, 2023	<u>Results of Monitoring and Assessment and Outreach and Education NOI Screening Notified</u> By this date, sponsors will be notified whether they are being invited to move forward in the application process.
March 22, 2023	<u>CWM Grant Application Deadline</u> By 5:00 p.m., submit all required grant materials via Foundant online platform .
Early April 2023	<u>Site Visits and Presentations</u> Grant applicants will host site visits and make presentations to the WRIA 8 Project Subcommittee. Exact Dates TBD. The schedule and timing will be confirmed with applicants following the application deadline.
Late April 2023	<u>Proposal Review and Ranking Meetings</u> WRIA 8 Project Subcommittee teams meet to review and rank proposals.
Early May 2023	<u>Funding Recommendations Finalized</u> Sponsors notified of proposal status
May 18, 2023	<u>WRIA 8 Salmon Recovery Council approval</u> Meeting to approve funding recommendations for transmittal to Flood Control District.
