# Overview

---

Funding: \$1,026,619

- \$954,819 allocated from KC FCD in 2020.
- \$71,800 in return funds (from 2017 CWM).

Scope:

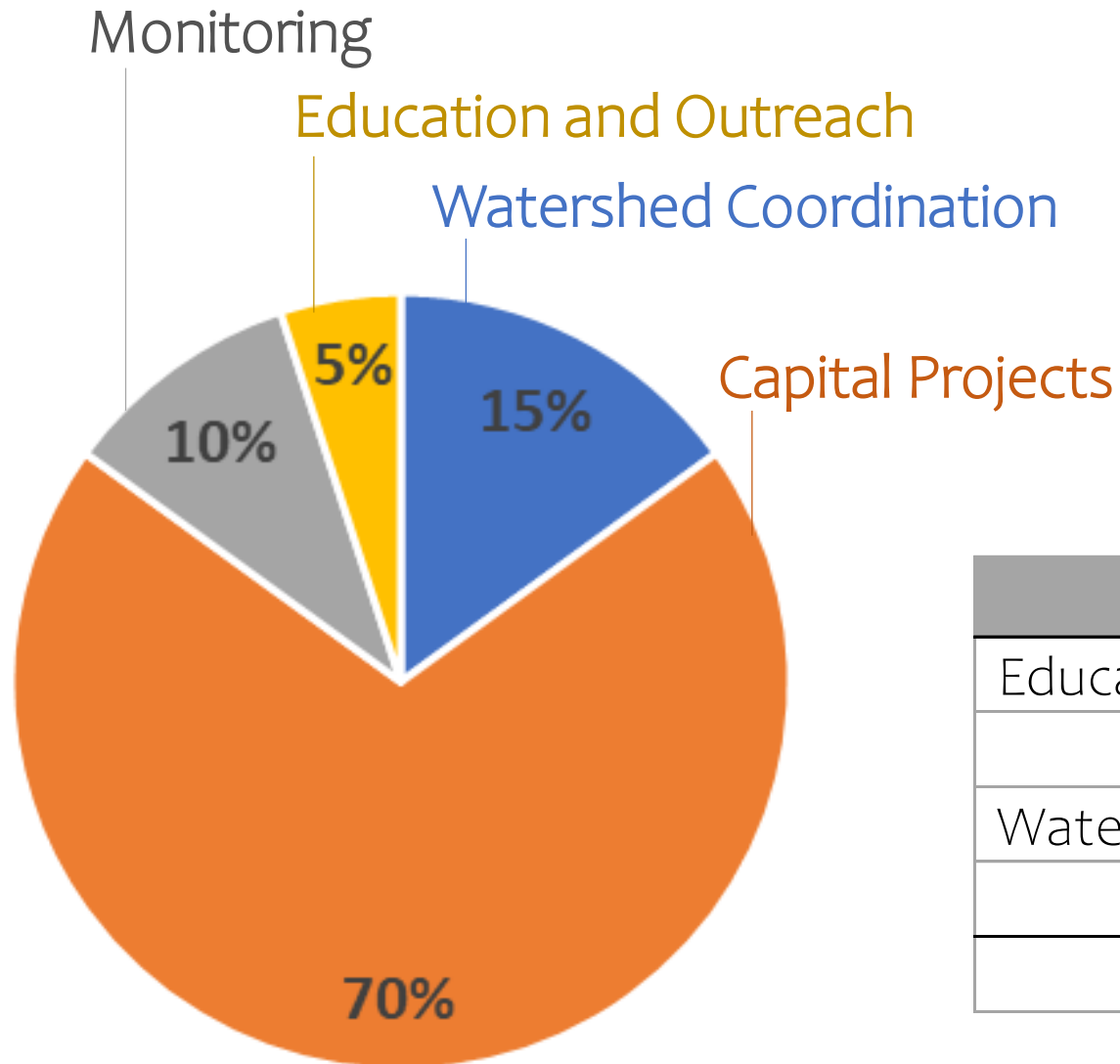
- Includes capital projects, watershed coordination, monitoring, and education projects. 3 year contracts.
- habitat projects focus on Chinook, but periodic focus on other species (Coho, Bull Trout, etc.)

Monitoring	10%	\$102,662
Watershed Coordination	15%	\$153,993
Capital Projects	70%	\$718,633
